Loretta Murray, 80, passed away on February 3, 2022, in Huntsville, TX. Loretta was born on January 15, 1942 in San Antonio, TX, to Lester and Ella Oleta Holmes. Loretta graduated from Robert E. Lee High school in Baytown, Texas in 1960 and went on to attend Sam Houston State University where she was a twirler. She started her career as a Legal Secretary and went on to work as a District Court Coordinator for Walker County where she later retired.
