Lottie Jones Price Lottie Jones Price of Coldspring passed away on December 26, 2012 at the age of 96. She was born June 27, 1916 at Hawthorn, TX. Lottie attended elementary school in Hawthorn, and then graduated from Willis High School as Salutatorian. Next she moved to Houston where she lived at the Womens' Business Club and attended Draughns' Business College. Her first job was in Conroe, where she was a court reporter and secretary to the County Judge. In 1936 she moved to Coldspring and worked first for John Browder, then for Jim Browder as Deputy County Clerk. In Coldspring she met and married James D. Price, editor and publisher of the San Jacinto Times. They were married on June 8, 1940. In 1946, Lottie left her job at the courthouse and became secretary for her brother M.C. Jones when he was named Superintendent of Coldspring-Oakhurst ISD. They worked together for the next 27 years until M.C. retired in 1973. Next Lottie was appointed Assistant Business Manager, a position she held until her retirement. On May 22, 1987, a retirement open house was held for "Miss Lottie." Coldspring mayor John Benestante proclaimed May 22 as Lottie Price Day. She served Coldspring-Oakhurst ISD for 41 years. During her retirement she loved to travel with her friends. Two of her favorite trips were an Alaska cruise and a tour of Israel. She especially enjoyed having lunch at the Senior Citizens Center, of which she was a member. Lottie was a long time member of the First Baptist Church of Coldspring, where she sang in the senior choir. She also belonged to the Texas Retired Teachers

Association. Lottie was preceded in death by her husband James Dickenson Price, her parents Robert Franklin and Mary Etta Dean Jones, her brothers Alton Jones, Elvin A Jones, Marvin Cleborne Jones and John Dee Jones, and sisters Penola Johnson and Clara Lee Rudd, and son-in-law John Charles Powell. She is survived by her daughter Alice Sharon Price Powell, her grandson James Charles Powell and wife Janet and great grandson Derek James Powell, all of San Antonio, Texas, and numerous nieces and nephews. Service will be held for Mrs. Price on Saturday, December 29, 2012, 11:00 a.m., at First Baptist Church, Coldspring, Texas, with Dr. Don Shannon officiating. Interment will follow at Laurel Hill Cemetery, Coldspring, Texas. Family will receive friends Friday, December 28, 2012, 5:30-7:30 p.m., at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home, Huntsville, Texas.
