She was preceded in death by her husband Bill and a son Billy and is survived by her son Bobby and his wife, Theresa and grandsons and wives William and Shaun, and Robert and Leigh. She was especially excited about the birth of her first great grandchild, Jacob and enjoyed seeing him grow and mature in the first two years of his life. Lu was raised in the Texas panhandle and married Billy McGill Fisher in 1939. After working in the Pantex Bomb factory during WWII, she and Bill began a life in the “oil patch” that took them from Texas to most of the western United States, Canada, and Venezuela. They went to Midland, Texas in 1974 and remained there until 2001 when . she moved to Montgomery, Texas to be near Bobby and Theresa. She was devoted to her family and her Church and taught Sunday school for many years. She spent much of her later years caring for Bill who was stricken with Alzheimer’s disease and died in 2003. An avid bridge player her entire adult life, she believed that it kept her “on top of her game”.
