Lynn Edward Davis was born to V. A. and Minnie Lee (Jordy) Davis in Huntsville March 3, 1925 and passed away September 20, 2005. He was born to one of the early families of Walker County going back to the 1830's and 1840's.

He served in the Pacific in WWII in the Army Air Corp. He joined the Air Force from 1943 to 1967. After retiring from the Air Force he moved to Florida and became a flight engineer with International Air Bahamas for 12 years. Then he was in real estate management in Florida until 2001. He moved back to Huntsville in 2002 after the death of his wife of over 50 years.

He has been a Masonic brother for 50 years. He was also a well know member of the Huntsville Cruisers car club winning many awards with his 1967 sky blue Mustang.

He is survived by a son, Howard Davis of Florida, and three sisters; Marylin Davis, Hazel David and Mrs. Betty Mott all of Huntsville.
