Margaret met the love of her life, Bill, in Galena Park at Middleton's grocery store where he worked as a butcher after serving in the US Army during WW II. After their wedding in 1947, they made Galena Park their home. Shortly after Bill's death in 2016, they would have celebrated their 69th anniversary.

Margaret was preceded in death by her husband William (Bill) Ferguson and her son Bill Ferguson, Jr. She is survived by her daughters, Sandra Jones of Madison, AL and Trena Benson and husband, Randy, of Montgomery, TX.

She was the loving "Memaw" to seven grandchildren and 13 great-

grandchildren.

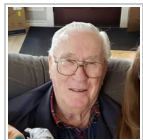
