Margaret Earlene Yeager passed away on Tuesday, July 4, 2023, in Texarkana, Texas. Margaret was born to Earl and Ruby Ellisor Yeager in Huntsville, Texas, on September 24, 1946. She was the oldest of four children. After living in Orange, Cleveland, and Corsicana, the family returned to Huntsville in 1959. She attended Huntsville schools and graduated from Huntsville High School in 1965. Margaret attended Sam Houston State College and then transferred to Texas Women's University in Denton. She received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Library Science with double minors in Spanish and History. She returned to southeast Texas and moved to Houston where she began work as a librarian at the Research and Development Library of the Lone Star Gas company.
