Alfre Marian "Pug" Dixon was born February 25, 1938 in Dodge, Texas to Gladys Roark and Alfred Dixon and passed away August 15, 2008 at her home in Huntsville, Texas. Marian fought a brave battle with lung cancer the past seventeen months. She grew up in Dodge, graduating from Huntsville High School in 1956. After moving to Houston she became a great soft ball player with the Houston Comets. Her dedication to the sport earned her induction into the US-ASA HOUSTON SOFT BALL HALL OF FAME in 1994. Her dedication also earned Certificates of Congratulation from the State of Texas House of Representatives and the Metro Houston Soft Ball Umpires Association. Marian was preceded in death by her parents; her brothers, Paul, George A., Kerry D., Zane and Wayne Dixon; and her sisters, Lois Luskie, Dorothy Jones, and Nell Sronce. Marian is survived by sisters, Jane Dixon and husband Joe Cobbs of Dodge, Nancy Dixon of New Orleans, and Cynthia Dixon Smith of Houston; sisters-in-law, Lilla, Mary Lou, and Gracie Dixon of Dodge; numerous nephews, nieces and a host of loved ones and friends.
