She then moved to Big Spring in January when her father was elected to office. She attended College Heights for seven years garnering lifelong friends that started school and graduated with her. She attended HCJC for one year and eventually graduated from Texas Tech in 1966. She then returned to Forsan ISD and taught everything from business, English, journalism, and history to P.E. Through the years she did the yearbook, the newspaper, sponsored the cheerleaders, the pep squad, and various classes and senior trips. In 1996, she decided to retire after 30 years in teaching. She was loved by her many friends and colleagues as well as two generations of her students – she so enjoyed helping them grow as young adults.
