She married Lloyd Lindsey in 1938 in Galveston, Texas and they had three children who were all born and raised on the island. She was divorced in 1980 after retiring to De Queen, AR and in 1983 she married H. J. Haralson who was the love of her life. They traveled everywhere they could, even to Alaska, Hawaii and the Panama Canal. They loved car trips, bus trips, cruises, Las Vegas and nearby casinos. H. J. passed away in 1995 leaving Martha Jane heartbroken.
