Mary was a respected insurance agent for over 20 years, helping many people with their insurance needs. She had a very loving and generous heart and loved animals. She was a favorite among many generations of nieces and nephews, always eager and willing to play games and host a slumber party, always there to help if it was at all possible for her to do so, if one of us was in need.
