Mary Elizabeth (Betty) Ruffer, 84, of The Woodlands, Texas, died peacefully in her sleep on Wednesday, July 12, 2017. A Catholic Mass will be celebrated at St. Mary's Church, 8227 County Road 205, Plantersville, Texas on Tuesday, July 25th at 10:30 AM. Burial will follow at the church cemetery.

Betty was born on May 4, 1933 in Newark, N.J. to Michael J. Breslin and Kathleen Carey Breslin. She is survived by her brother Michael J. Breslin and sister, Kathleen Breslin. She was raised in Rutherford, N.J. and graduated from Jersey City Medical Center School of Nursing with an RN.

As a Walden resident, she was an active member of the Walden Ladies Golf Association, past president of

the Walden Ladies Association and an avid bridge player.

In Colonial Dames, she set up a program which helps the chapter give scholarships to Lone Star College students.
