Marylin Yvone Clark Parsley died on July 18, 2020 from a long battle with Alzheimers. She is preceded in death by her parents T.M. and Daphne Clark of Ennis, TX and her second husband Harry Edward Parsley and her last husband Tilden (Ted) Clark.

was to Egypt to visit a special friend named Amy. She was a very social person and was a fierce defender of her family. She cared for her mother, Daphne for 4 years when Daphne was suffering from Alzheimer's as well. Marilyn will be missed by her family, friends and many followers of the Mom Chronicles.
