On August 1, 2010, he passed away at his home in New Waverly, Texas at age 74. Survived by wife Lillie. Loving father and grandfather to 7 children, 9 grandchildren, and 11 great-grandchildren. "Preacher" served in the army during the Korean War and received an honorable discharge in 1962. He attended Sam Houston State University, where he received a B.S. in Criminal Justice in 1974 and went on to work as a Texas State Trooper for several years and then for Johnson Controls where he retired. He was a member of the Pipefitter's Union Local #211, a member and Past Master of San Jacinto Lodge #106 A.F. & A.M. and 33 Degree with the Houston Scottish Right Bodies. He was an avid outdoorsman and loved helping others.
