Michael (Mike) Bailey Bain went to be with our Lord and Savior on September 5, 2023. He was born August 20, 1961 in Tyler, Texas to parents William “Bill” and Jo Ann Bain. He was raised in Alief, TX and was a pole-vaulter and football player for Alief-Elsik High School. He attended Tyler Junior College where he earned an associates degree in Petroleum Technology with honors. He then married and had two children with his first wife Ginny Sherbit. He worked in the oilfield on offshore oil rigs and then began working in the pest control industry. On March 12th, 1995 he married Wendy Tankersley and they spent 27 years together raising five children and 13 grandchildren. He was a business partner and then owner of Morris Pest Control and served the community for 20 years.

Mike most enjoyed spending time with his family and friends. He was surrounded by love throughout his life with numerous relatives, business partnerships, long-time customers he considered family, and the numerous friendships he made and maintained along the way. When his kids were younger, he and Wendy loaded them up in a van and took them to spend the weekends on the lake, tubing and skiing all weekend long. After the children grew up, he and Wendy spent weekends on the golf course in their community-April Sound and developed a large, tight-knit group of friends. Mike loved to be outside and never met a stranger. He greeted everyone with a smile, firm handshake, and very often, a joke. He loved to make people

laugh and never wanted life to be taken too seriously. He did not sweat the small stuff. Mike was a hard-working, independent, responsible, go-getter and never missed a day of work.

Mike was a Christian and often took his children to church when they were growing up at Spring Baptist Church and then The Woodlands Church. A few weeks before passing, Mike assured one of his daughters that he did not fear death. He calmly and confidently stated that he had such an incredibly blessed life that was so full. He also knew that he had very special people that would greet him the moment he took his first breath in heaven.
