Michael Edward Finn, 74 of Trinity, TX passed away peacefully at home with his beloved wife Norene by his side. At sunset on Thursday, June 15, 2023, the angels ushered him home to be with our Heavenly Father.

Michael was born to Michael and Dorothy Finn in South Boston, Massachusetts in 1948 and is the oldest of seven children. He enlisted in the United States Army and served our great country honorably from 1969-1971. Deservingly so, Sergeant Finn was a proud Vietnam Veteran. During his service, he was a Combat Engineer and received the National Defense Service Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal with 4 Bronze Service Stars, the Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, and the Good Conduct Medal.
