On September 6, 1951, a baby boy was born to Mr. James Ware and Mrs. Earnestine Smith Ware of Huntsville, Texas. They named him Michael Smith. He grew up in The Friendship Baptist Church under leadership of Rev. M.C. Battle.

Michael graduated from Huntsville High School in the Class of 1970. On July 4, 1973, he married his high school sweetheart, Ms. Mary J. Spivey and to this union two daughters were born.

Michael worked for the Texas Department of Criminal Justice beginning his career at the Darrington Unit in Rosharon, Texas in 1973. He then moved his family back to Huntsville and continued with the agency until he retired in 2005. He came out of retirement and returned to the agency for another 6 years totaling 38 years of dedicated service.
