Her professional career after high school graduation included work in real estate, office manager for Glazier Frosted Food Co. in Austin, Texas and secretary-treasurer of Transformer Electronics Co. in Boulder, Colorado. She was an active participant in civic affairs and performed volunteer work in Boulder and subsequently in Dallas where she and her husband lived before moving to Huntsville in 1971. Here, she lectured on art appreciation to elementary school students, worked with MADD, and also was a volunteer at the Sam Houston Memorial Museum. Mrs. Price is survived by her husband, Robert; son, Jack and grandson Sean, both of Dallas; sister, Vora Nell Schmidt of Killeen; as well as by numerous nieces and nephews. She was a long time member of the First Christian Church of Huntsville. Funeral services for Mrs. Price will be held Saturday, April 28, 2012, 10:00 a.m., at First Christian Church in Huntsville, Texas, with Pastor Kyle Dennis officiating.
