The 5th of 6 children of Arthur and Edith Cordrey, she was born in Rushsylvania, Ohio, on May 28, 1919, helped her parents on the farm and graduated from Rushsylvania High School. After marrying, she moved to the Marion, Ohio, area and lived there most of her adult life. She was active in the Green Camp United Methodist Church, preserved fruits and vegetables from her large garden, sewed clothes for her children and grandchildren, worked at J.C. Penney in Marion after rearing her two children, and treasured her close relationships with the Slack and Cordrey families. In 2001, she moved to Huntsville, TX, to be near her daughter. She is preceded in death by her husband of 45 years, John W. Slack and their son William J.
