



## Morris Dean "Bo" Bolton Sr

June 7, 1929 - July 4, 2018

Funeral services for Morris Dean "Bo" Bolton, Sr. of Huntsville, Texas will be held on Saturday, July 7, 2018 at 10:00 am at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home in Huntsville, with the Chaplain John Larson officiating. Bo was born on June 7, 1929 in Tecula, TX to Archie and Bernice Bullock Bolton and entered into rest peacefully in his sleep on July 4, 2018. Bo served as a sergeant in the United States Army during the Korean War from 1952-54.
