Nancy May Penney, 89, passed away on May 17, 2023, in Montgomery, Texas, surrounded by her loved ones. She was born on May 23, 1933, in Great Bend, Kansas, to Grace Ellen Fish Dalton and Theodore Layton Harvey.

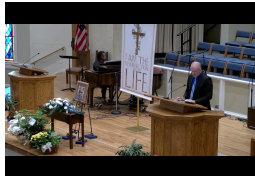
