April 22, 1925 - August 21, 2006

Naomi Jane Edwards Corley, 81, of Huntsville went home to be with the Lord on August 17, 2006. She died in a Houston hospital due to complications from diabetes. She was surrounded by her loved ones at the time of her death. Naomi was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, sister and friend to all. She was born April 22, 1925 in Ashland, Ohio to Shelby and Olive Edwards. Naomi graduated from Ashland High School and attended Ohio State University and Sam Houston State University. Naomi loved the Lord and was a lifetime member of First United Methodist Church in Huntsville. Before her failing health, she was active in the community. She worked with the Welcome Wagon Program for the City of Huntsville and also owned and operated Southern Beat Signing Telegram and Balloon Services. She was a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution, Delta Zeta Sorority Alumni, Sam Houston State University Faculty Wives and Huntsville Memorial Hospital Auxiliary. She was preceded in death by her husband of 43 years (married April 28, 1944), Laurence Lester "Larry" Corley; her parents Shelby James Edwards and Olive Lucille Matthews Edwards; brothers Richard Edwards and Shelby Edwards Jr., and sisters Marilyn Edwards Deucher and Elaine Edwards Buckway.
