Nat Hart Davis, Jr. passed away on August 16, 2021 at home surrounded by family. He was born December 16, 1931, in Houston, Texas, at St. Joseph Maternity Center, the third child of Nat Hart and Mabel Spiller Davis. The family lived in Houston and returned to Conroe in 1937 and he graduated from Conroe High School in 1950. Nat enrolled in University of Texas. He was to be called up for Military Service, and joined the Air Force, serving in Korea. In 1958, he married his love, Leah Lynn Shawver. He graduated in 1959 from the University of Houston. He was accepted and entered South Texas College of Law and Graduated and passed the Bar in 1962. He joined the Masonic Lodge and received his 60 year Certificate from Montgomery Lodge #25. He was a member of the 9th Degree team and received his 50 year Certificate from the Scottish Rite. He had been an Attorney at Law over 50 years. He was a member of the Sons of the Republic of Texas. He was a lifelong Democrat.
