Neil Bradley Simonsen, 59, of Willis, Texas, passed away in his home on March 29, 2010. Neil was born July 18, 1950, in Council Bluffs, Iowa, to Egon and Alice Simonsen. He was raised in Elk Horn, IA, graduating from Elk Horn High School in 1968. Neil was honorably discharged as a Sergeant after service with the Colorado and Iowa Army National Guard, before moving to Texas. He married Julie Bell in Willis, TX, in 1981. Together for 19 years, they raised two children. He worked at Gulf States Utilities Company for 18 years before becoming a self employed business owner for the next 14 years.
