January 2, 1945 - September 29, 2016

Nell Rae Lambert was born on January 2, 1945 in Houston, Texas. She was the second child and only daughter of Justice F. Counts, Sr. and Wilda J. Counts. She graduated from Lutheran South High School in Houston in 1963 and studied nursing at Sacred Heart for two years afterward.

Nell is most remembered for serving as a Justice of the Peace for the citizens of Precinct #4 in San Jacinto County—first as a clerk through most of the 1980's for her father, Justice Sr., until the conclusion of her own tenure in 1998. Nell had a variety of interest including antiques, arts and crafts, and reading. Nell is also a cancer survivor having battled ovarian cancer during her teen years.

Nell is survived by husband Thomas Edward Lambert, Sr. of Coldspring, TX, brother Justice Counts, Jr. of The Woodlands, TX, son Kenneth Ray Anderson of Coldspring, TX and Thomas Anthony Anderson of Waller, Texas. She is also a proud grandparent of Ashlee Nicole Anderson and Allyson Renee Anderson, both of Waller, Texas.
