



Nina Delores Toole Randall

June 3, 1944 - April 13, 2024

Nina Delores Toole Randall passed away at her home on April 13, 2024 at the age of 79 in Houston, Texas. She was born on June 3, 1944 in Huntsville, Texas to Thomas Fredrick Toole and Bertha Inez Pierce. She married Richard Randall at the Dallas Texas Temple of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints on September 3, 1994.

She is survived by her husband Richard Randall, of 31 years, her brother Jerry Don Toole and numerous nieces and nephews. She is preceded in death by her parents and her brother Hal Lamond Toole.

Nina graduated from Coldspring High School in 1962. She attended and received a degree from a business school in Lufkin, Texas. She then went on to a long and successful career as an executive assistant. She began her career in Houston, Texas working for Gulf Aerospace followed by employment at Baroid Corporation, National Lead and Halliburton. She retired after more than 40 years of employment.

Nina was an inaugural member of the Huntsville Branch/Ward of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints which had its beginning around 1949 in Huntsville. She was baptized August 16, 1955 and served in the ward in many capacities throughout her life, including in the Stake President's office. Her favorite calling was teaching primary children about the Savior. Nina had

many hobbies she cherished including bowling, in which she won many trophies. She was also an avid collector of dolls and figurines. Her favorite pastime was hunting for treasures in thrift stores and flea markets.

Nina's greatest love was her family and she devoted her life to caring for them. Although she always maintained a Houston residence, she would spend most weekends with her parents and siblings at their home in Oakhurst, Texas. Nina will be remembered as one who loved God and her fellowmen.

Services for Nina will be held on April 21, 2024 at The Huntsville Chapel of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints starting at 2:00 pm. The burial service will immediately follow at Mt. Capers Cemetery in Oakhurst, Texas. Serving as pallbearers are Clayton Toole, Lincoln Toole, Jason Toole, Weston Toole, Jeremy Toole and Gene Ballew.
