Norm attended Fellowship of Huntsville Church since moving to Huntsville in 2006, was married there on September 16, 2006, and raised his family there. He owned Cabins and More of Texas where he enjoyed working hard to

provide for his family, and he loved serving his customers well. Norm was excited to be a board member and Chaplain for the Trail Life scouting troop recently chartered by Fellowship of Huntsville, he had looked forward to ministering to the young men in the group, challenging them to grow in character, understanding their purpose, and developing practical leadership skills to carry out the mission for which they were created.
