OLIVER JAMES MOAK Oliver James "O.J." Moak, 82, of Huntsville, Texas went to be with the Lord on March 28, 2014, surrounded by his family. O.J. was born June 6, 1931 in San Antonio, Texas to Oliver Joe Moak and Clotee Brent Moak. He graduated from South Park High School in 1949 and continued his education earning an Bachelor of Science Degree from Texas A & M College in 1953, and a Juris Doctorate degree from South Texas College of Law in 1971. O.J. had two children, a son, Sam A. Moak and a daughter, Pamela Kay Moak. O.J. was appointed as the first staff counsel for inmates by Dr. George Beto in 1971. O.J. was also Assistant County Attorney for Walker County, Texas. O.J. established the Huntsville, Texas law firm of Moak & Moak, P.C. in 1972. Together, O.J. and his son, Sam, practiced law until his retirement in 2003. Additionally, O.J. owned and operated Sam Houston Landmark Title Company from 1986 until his retirement in 2003. O.J. was a longtime member of First Christian Church Disciples of Christ; a member and past president of Kiwanis Club of Huntsville; a member of the Walker County Hospital Authority; a lifetime member and former Chairman of the Broiler Committee for the Walker County Fair Association; and a member of the Walker County Bar Association. O.J. was also a member of the morning and lunch crew at the Café Texan who met daily to jab each other and solve the world's problems. O.J. is survived by his daughter, Pamela Kay Moak; son, Sam A. Moak and wife, Cathy, grandsons Jacob Alexander Moak and William "Billy" Walker Moak; and numerous cousins, nieces, and nephews and

extended family members. O.J. was preceded in death by his father and mother Mr. and Mrs. Oliver Joe Moak and brother, Billy Joe Moak. Visitation will be held on Saturday, April 5th from 2:00-4:00 p.m. at First Christian Church Disciples of Christ (1800 Ave. R, Huntsville, TX).
