Patrick Shane Glasgow, age 7, of Huntsville, Texas died as a result of injuries sustained in a car crash near Franklin, Texas on March 14, 2018.

Patrick was born on September 9, 2010 in Huntsville, Texas to parents Kristi and Rory Glasgow. He was a “welcome surprise” to the family and was adored by all. Patrick was a loving and empathetic child who loved music, video games, and playing with Legos. His favorite color was rainbow and he loved the Oz books by L. Frank Baum. He attended The Children’s House preschool before starting Kindergarten at Huntsville Elementary School. He was in first grade at the time of his passing. He adored his teacher, Mrs. Jamie, Mrs. Dowell, and Ms. Walker.

Despite his young age, Patrick has a profound impact on a great number of people. His winning smile, gentle character, and loving nature made him a favorite wherever he went. He enjoyed visiting Huntsville’s play parks, seeing “Mr. Merle” at G&O Barbershop for a haircut, and eating at his favorite restaurants and treat shops: Luigi’s, Los Pericos, Daisy’s Diner, China House, Chicken Express, and 3 Spoons. He and his father were regulars at the SHSU Planetarium and Observatory. He also enjoyed going on walks and playing with his older brother, Bryan.
