Patrick Bruce Nelson, loving husband to Teresita and father to Christopher Nelson, died on August 31, 2014. He resided in Huntsville, Texas. Patrick was 60 years old. Pat was born September 6, 1953 in Louisville, Kentucky. He grew up among family and friends and graduated from Louisville's Fern Creek High School in the class of 1971. He continued his education at Southern Illinois University, Carbondale, Illinois graduating with a degree in Technology and receiving a second degree in Education from Sam Houston University, Huntsville, Texas in 1999. The master of many trades, Patrick's true passion was education. He taught in the Brenham, Conroe and Huntsville school districts and retired from teaching in 2012. Patrick later returned to the working community in 2013 as the supervisor of maintenance at the Facilities Department of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, Huntsville. He instilled in his son, his love of music and inspired Christopher to become a musician and join the Huntsville Marching Band.
