They hand painted tin cans to be filled with many different flavors of popcorn to choose from. These same ladies were also responsible for the Hornet Hoedown from 1982 - 1992. They made up skits and songs in the Hee Haw

themed production to honor the senior class.

In the 90's she was asked by a friend to plan a wedding. She never backed away from a project or the chance to help someone. Before you knew it, she had planned and coordinated several weddings for friends, family and even a few professional athletes.

Patsy's love for Hornet football was second to none. She rarely missed a game and still supported the team even after her kids were out of school. The year the team went to the State Championship, and all playoff games she and her crew decorated I45 with Luv ya Green posters and giant head shots of the players.

Those that knew her, loved her, and there are countless stories of the lives she touched.

She had four loves in her life; God, Family, Elvis and the most recent addition to the list, President Trump.

Patsy, Mom, Aunt Pat, Nannie, you will be missed but never forgotten. We love you and will see you again.
