Farmer and family man Paul Edward Cluxton's love of life and of simple, yet beautiful things, did not come to an end with his death. Paul passed away on May 10, 2024, at the age of 82, after a long, courageous battle with renal cancer. 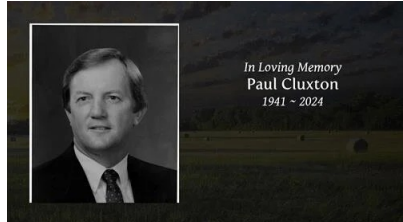
