



## Perry Morris

April 10, 1923 - September 13, 2014

Perry Daniel Morris, age 91, passed away at Saint Joseph Hospital in Bryan, Texas on Monday September 1, 2014. He was born on April 10, 1923 in Flatonia, Texas to Van Daniel (Jack) Morris and Edith Lueders Morris. He was Meat & Poultry Inspector for many years in Houston, Texas. He lived in New Waverly, Texas the past twenty one years. He was also an avid motorcyclist and loved to travel. He was a MASON for the past 65 + years. Perry was a member of the Eagle Lake Lodge for 50 + years. He was a member of the John Sims Lodge No. 458 A.F. and A.M. in New Waverly, Texas. Perry was of John Sims Lodge #458 A.F. and A.M. a Past Master and served as Chaplin from 2010 to 2014. He received the Golden Trowel Award on October 25, 2011. He was also deeply involved in Katy Morris Scholarship Foundation. Perry Morris became active in the Army on January 29 1943. He fought in the Invasion of Normandy, in Northern France, during World War II. He earned the American Theater Campaign Medal, E A M E Campaign Medal, 2 Bronze Stars, Good Conduct Medal, Meritorious Unit Award, Victory Ribbon, 1 Service Stripe, and 3 Overseas Service Bars. Perry Daniel Morris was preceded in death by his wife (Katy Morris) and parents. He leaves to cherish his memory: his granddaughter Shayna Burgess (Joshua Sr.), four great-grandchildren (Jeremiah, Xavier, Alexis, and Joshua Jr.), brother-in-law Joe Frost and wife Gloria, sister-in-law Jacqueline Tisdale and husband Jimmy, close friend (Beverly Justis), and many other friends.
