Raymond Rice Ray was born in Jenkins, Kentucky to Bernice and Sarah Spears Rice on July of 1922. He joined the Army in 1939 serving in Panama and the Pacific during WWII. Ray later re-enlisted into the Air Force from which he retired in 1962. After retirement, Ray worked in the newspaper business working as the editor of the local papers in Grangeville, Idaho and Grafton, West Virginia. In 1973, Ray moved to Huntsville Texas and went to work at the Texas Dept. of Corrections where he managed the prison store and worked in industry. He retired from TDC and opened the original Trophy Case across from eh current location. He enjoyed his involvement with the Elks Lodge #1981 serving over the years in several elected offices locally and in the state hierarchy. He also enjoyed trips to the casinos in Louisiana.
