



## Rebecca "Becky" L. Bilnoski

Rebecca Lou Shaw Bilnoski went to be with the Lord on Thursday, August 15, 2024. Becky was born in Pasadena, Texas to Clifford Lee Shaw Jr. and Dorothy Rose Shaw on August 28, 1956. Becky was a graduate of Galena Park High School where she was a twirler and award-winning flutist and piccoloist. Her love for music would carry on throughout her life. Her particular fondness of Rock n Roll and country music would later pass down to her children and grandchildren.

She married the love of her life, Marvin Bilnoski Jr. on June 5, 1976. Butch and Becky settled in Highlands, TX where Becky devoted her life to raising her two children, Buck and Leah, and later loving her grandchildren. Becky was a devout Catholic and often walked to the 6am mass as a child. She later became the secretary for Our Lady Fatima Church and School. Following her move to Highlands, she taught catechism classes at St. Jude's Catholic Church ensuring her children received their religious education. Becky was an enthusiastic lover of all sports and could cite statistics better than most analysts. She was especially fond of girls' sports and spent many of her years in Highlands helping with the Highlands Sports Association and coaching girls' softball. always be loved and remembered.
