Rebekah passed away with her daughter, son and husband by her side Monday at Conroe Regional Medical Center. She was born August 10, 1958 in San Antonio to Reverend Ernest and Sadie Pankhurst and married Herbert Leslie Smith III (Leslie) on June 6, 1987.

Rebekah was a schoolteacher for 35 years, 25 of which were spent with Huntsville Independent School District. She taught home economics at Huntsville High School and kindergarten at Huntsville Elementary School. She then went on to teach early childhood education at Sam Houston State University.

Survivors include her husband, Leslie Smith of Huntsville; children, Sarah and Travis Jordan (TJ) Smith of San Marcos; sisters Esther Stafford of Kingwood, Tina Toole of Palestine and Sue Matthey of San Antonio; brother Carl Pankhurst of Irondale, Missouri; brother-in-law David Smith of Spicewood; sister-in-law Kathy Dorety of Athens; 13 nieces and nephews; 16 great-nieces and nephews; and 1 great-great-niece. Her parents, Sadie Pankhurst and Reverend Ernest Pankhurst, precede her in death.

A gathering of Rebekah's family and friends will begin at 10:00 a.m., with her funeral service to follow at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 21, 2018 at First Baptist Church, 1229 Avenue J, Huntsville, TX.

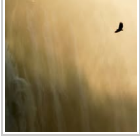

I sweep the grass, that hides your stone, beneath the shaded tree.*

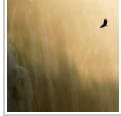
*I promised that I would not cry on, days I came to visit.
