Retha Joanne Todd, 84, of College Station, Texas, peacefully passed away on September 26th at her son Mike's home in Montgomery, Texas.

Memorial services and a celebration of her life will be held in College Station at a time yet to be determined.

Retha was born in Tacoma, Washington to Grace and Lyle Bass on July 25, 1935. She married Jackie Lee Todd on December 27, 1952 in Tacoma.
