Robert G. Ernst A memorial service for Robert Garfield Ernst will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, April 7, 2013 at First Presbyterian Church, Huntsville, Texas, with the Reverend Diane Prevary officiating. Mr. Ernst was born in New Jersey and graduated from Lafayette College as a chemical engineer. During WWII, he was a navigator in the U.S. Army Air Corps serving on B-17's in England. In 1950, Mr. Ernst married Patricia Jeter. Bob worked in the oil industry for 34 years in the U.S., India and the Philippines. Upon retiring in 1982, he and Pat moved to a small tree farm in Huntsville, Texas. He is survived by his wife Patricia, son Robert Frederic Ernst, daughter Elizabeth Ernst Green, sister Jane Ernst Remy, brother John Mager Ernst, 12 grandchildren and 11 great grandchildren. He is preceded in death by son William Jeter Ernst. Bob served on the Rita B. Huff Humane Society board of directors for years, and had also been active with the Good Shepherd Mission, Walker County Timber Growers, and AARP Tax Counseling.
