



## Robert "Bob" David Feldman

June 23, 1926 - January 28, 2011

Robert (Bob) David Feldman was born on June 23, 1926 in The Bronx, New York and passed away peacefully on Friday January 28, 2011.

Bob was a genuine person and a great patriot. He loved his family and his country more than anything. This patriotism and generosity have been an inspiration for many.

Bob served in the US Navy during WWII on the USS Minivet. His ship hit a mine and sank in the icy waters of Japan in December 1945, 2 days before the war was over. God took his hand to the front of the ship that day, as He did many other times in his life. His experiences in the Navy shaped his life for many years to come. He was discharged in June 1946 with honorable service and decorated with a number medals, including the Silver and Bronze star. He was most proud of his service to his country.

He was united in marriage to Mary Kathryn Fischer on August 6, 1955 in Hamilton Ohio. Their marriage was blessed with the birth of four children: Lance, Stephanie, Melanie and Mark.

As a result of Bob's various assignments with Allied Department Stores, Bob and Mary moved from Hamilton, OH to Springfield, OH, Houston, TX, Akron, OH, Scottsdale, AZ, and back to Houston. After retiring, Bob & Mary built their

dream home in April Sound on Lake Conroe. They enjoyed having their children and their families spend time with them there.

Bob's love of travel, adventure, and the sea stayed with him throughout his life. As a result, Bob & Mary took many trips and cruises to places such as Europe, Hawaii, and many places throughout the United States & Canada.

Among those left behind to mourn Bob's death and to celebrate his life are his wife Mary; children Lance and his wife Mavis of Willis, TX; Stephanie and her husband Peter Poorman of Plano, TX; Melanie and her husband Randy Rippentrop of The Woodlands, TX; and Mark and his wife Kris of Magnolia, TX. He is also survived by his loving grandchildren; Gracia and her husband Nick, Jacob, David, Megan, Lauren, Kort, Kole, Mason and Grant. Bob was preceded in death by his parents; Lillian and Max Feldman, and his sister Geraldine Abel.
