“ My family was very sorry to see that Bobby had passed. My dad and I umpired many, many games with him over the years – my dad since the mid-60’s or so and me since the mid-70’s. When the scheduler gave us our assignments for the week it was always great to hear when we knew we were going to work a game with Bobby. He was not only a fine umpire but a great teacher and role model as well. You knew that there likely wouldn’t be many problems on the field when Bobby was with you because he knew the rules and had great judgment; he hustled and knew where he needed to be for the best position to make a call; and he was highly respected by players and coaches as well as his fellow umpires. The respect he had as an umpire earned him an awful lot of high school playoff games and many, many games at the college level. He was a fine gentleman on and off the field. My dad is in a nursing home in Deer Park. He and Bobby are the same age – my dad will turn 90 on June 30. I asked him yesterday if he remembered Bobby Schroeder. He didn’t remember what he had for lunch yesterday but when I asked him about Bobby he said – “yeah – he was a damned fine umpire.” I didn’t have the heart to tell him that he had passed.
