



Robert "Scotty" Manson

March 26, 1937 - March 9, 2015

Robert "Scotty" Manson passed peacefully at Conroe Regional Medical Center on March 9, 2015, due to complications from an Aortic Aneurysm. He was 77.

Scotty was born in Edinburgh, Scotland on March 26, 1937. He graduated from the Queen Victoria Military School in Dunblane, Scotland in 1953. While attending the Queen Victoria School, he studied as a piper and highland dancer. After military boarding school, he was accepted as an apprentice mechanic specializing in diesel engines. Scotty and his family immigrated to the United States on May 18, 1973, and settled in Denver, Colorado, where he continued his career as a diesel mechanic and later held a position as an instructor at the Denver Diesel and Automotive College.

In his retirement, Scotty loved to travel and cruise with friends throughout the world. He frequently returned to Scotland where he always visited his boyhood school in Dunblane and often participated in the annual "Old Boys Day" reunion and celebration. Scotty was a loyal football supporter of Hibernian FC in the Scottish Premier League and Stoke City FC in the English Premier League. Scotty's passion for soccer led him to pursue volunteer coaching for over 15 years in the Denver area junior and adult soccer leagues.

Scotty was an outgoing and charismatic wee Scotsman who touched and befriended all. Scotty is survived by his wife of 56 years Dorothy; his three sons, Garry Manson and wife Heather of Raleigh, North Carolina, Anthony Manson and wife Mary of Dover, Delaware and Robert Manson of Littleton, Colorado; his sister Henna and husband Larry Busboom of Tucson, Arizona. Scotty and Dotty were blessed with five grandchildren and five great grandchildren.

A memorial service honoring Robert "Scotty" Manson will be held at the Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home in Montgomery, Texas, on Friday, March 13, 2015, at 1100.
