Robin was born on November 4, 1961 in Salisbury, Maryland to Melvin and Darlene Hazel. She was preceded in death by her mother, Darlene Hazel. Robin is survived by her husband of 28 years, Jay Lowe, her son James Calvin Lowe, III, her father Melvin Hazel, her sister and brother-in-law, Ann Hazel Kelley and Mark Kelley, brother and sister-in-law, Eddie Hazel and LaShane Hazel, her mother-in-law, Mary Ella Lowe, brother-in-law, Mark Lowe; her four beloved nieces, Rachel Kelley, Tori Mitchell, Kaci Hazel and Rylee Hazel; aunts and uncles, Sherry and Mike Dukes, Jack Hazel, Nettie Nicholson, Ruth Steimer and numerous cousins and her special friends, Regina Montagna and Josie Picket and Josies' daughter whom Robin considered her niece, Caroline Erb. Robin grew up in Berlin, Maryland and attended Stephen Decatur High School before moving to Houston with her family in 1977. She graduated from Stratford Senior High in 1979. Robin maintained close friendships with her friends from both schools and always attended reunions from both schools. In 1983, Robin graduated from Sam Houston State University with a degree in Criminology and Corrections and in April 1984 began working in Human Resources at the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. She specialized in the areas of EEO and Labor relations and was often called upon by the Attorney Generals office to provide expert testimony in litigation of these areas. In the workplace, Robin was known for her commitment to ensuring

agency policies were followed. She was direct, but you always knew she would give you a straight answer. If you were wrong, she would tell you and offer up a solution. If you were right, she would tell you that too. Robin retired from the Texas Department of Criminal Justice on July 31, 2011, at the Labor Relations Director for the TDCJ. Robin was a long time board member of the SAAFEHOUSE of Walker County and believed it was her responsibility to give back to her community. Robin accepted Jesus Christ as her personal Lord and Savior as a young girl and was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Huntsville at the time of her death. Robin often said her faith enabled her not to fear death as she knew she would have everlasting life. Robin's faith guided how she lived her life. Robin was also very passionate that the world should be educated on the myths and truths related to living with metastatic breast cancer. She was an active poster on bcmets.org. Although diagnosed with a terminal illness in 2004, Robin LIVED. It was important to her that others see that one could enjoy life even when diagnosed with a disease that had no cure. Robin loved to travel, especially to see her beloved Ocean City. Like her mother, Robin liked to "go". She loved spending time with her family whom she loved beyond measure. She was an active poster on Copykat, neopets and bcmets.org. Robin's family joked that they never went anywhere in the world where she did not know someone. Robin is also survived by many close friends. Robin wanted to thank her family and friends for their support. She often said "Life is a gift and you do not get a do over so make this one count." Her family would like to thank her friends who have supported her during the last few months of her fight who provided meals, comfort, drives to chemotherapy treatments. Visitation will be Thursday, March 1, 2012, from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m., at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home in Huntsville, Texas. Services will be Friday, March 2, 2012, 10:00 a.m., at First United Methodist Church, Huntsville, Texas with Rev. Mark Pickett officiating. Interment will follow at Mayes Addition of Oakwood Cemetery in Huntsville, Texas. Immediately following the service, all are invited to greet the family during a reception in the adjacent Fellowship Hall at

First United Methodist Church in Huntsville, Texas. Serving as pallbearers are Josie Picket, Lester Childres, Elizabeth Mullen, Matthew Mears, Joel Johnson, and Laurence Myers.
