Ronnie was born September 23, 1948 and went home to be with his Lord and Savior on February 23, 2017 at 68 years of age. He is survived by his wife of 45 years Joyce Lorraine Williams who he loved with all his heart, his children David Williams and wife Andrea, Dana Black and husband Stephen, Delanie Pruitt and husband Jeremy, grandchildren Ashley Cardenas and husband Eddie, Colton, Chase and Jessie Williams, Ethan, Jamie, Abigail, and Joel Pruitt, his sisters Anne Ackel, Rochelle Schultz and husband David, and many nieces, nephews and friends. He is preceded in death by his parents Earl and Mary Williams, brothers Charles "Bubba", Donnie, Joey, and grandson Jacob Pruitt.

PFC Ronald Williams served, with Valor, the country he loved so dearly from August 1969 to September 1971. Assigned to the 9th infantry division, he fought in the Vietnam War and received the purple heart after injuries he suffered during combat. It took many years for Ronnie to start talking about the war, but once he did it was hard to get him to stop.

Ronnie accepted Christ at a young age and faithfully served his Lord until he was called home. He taught Sunday school and built more than a few church buildings for worship. He took his efforts to be Christ-like a step further than

most and became a carpenter and a fisher. When the preacher said that Jesus was a fisher of men Ronnie must have headed to the lake before he heard the “of men” part, because he religiously fished for bass every week. He and his long-time fishing buddy, Bruce, would compete to see which one would be “skunked” that week. He could build or fix most anything. He created a house full of whatever hand crafted furniture that his wife could dream up. Building and fixing things for people is one of the ways Ronnie showed love, and his family felt his love.
