Roy A. Norman of Huntsville, Texas was called home by his Heavenly Father on June 22, 2015. Roy was born on November 15, 1930, in Oglesby, Texas, to George T. Norman and Gertrude Helen Webb Norman.

He was inducted into the United States Army on April 19, 1950. He served as a Medic in Germany during the Korean War until he was honorably discharged on March 27, 1953. On June 16, 1951, he married his high school sweetheart, Nelda June Pratt.
