Russell Dean Nimz was born on June 18, 1942 in Blue Earth, MN to Dorothy and Herman Nimz. He passed away in Conroe, Texas on March 27, 2020 at the age of 77.

After graduating from Blue Earth High School, Russell proudly joined the US Air Force. While stationed in Louisiana, he met the love of his life, Mary Lasyone, on a blind date. He served bravely during the Vietnam War and was honorably discharged in 1966. He raised his family in a small town, Midland, TX. Russell managed the flight line for private airplanes at the Midland Airport, managed sales at Circle B Homes, and later owned and operated Russell's Pest Control. In 1996, he retired to Lake LBJ and drove cars across the country for the "Ford House."
