Following his dream to be a Software Engineer, he graduated from Sam Houston State University in 2006 with a degree in Computer Science and soon got a job at Weatherford Inc., where he has worked for 16 years.

Sean was a selfless, kind-hearted, and generous person. He was always quick to help out wherever he could, especially in the kitchen, where he infused his love for science and chemistry into his cooking. His favorite things were tinkering with electronics, building computers, playing video games, creating things on his 3D printers, playing with the family dogs and driving with the top down on his convertible.

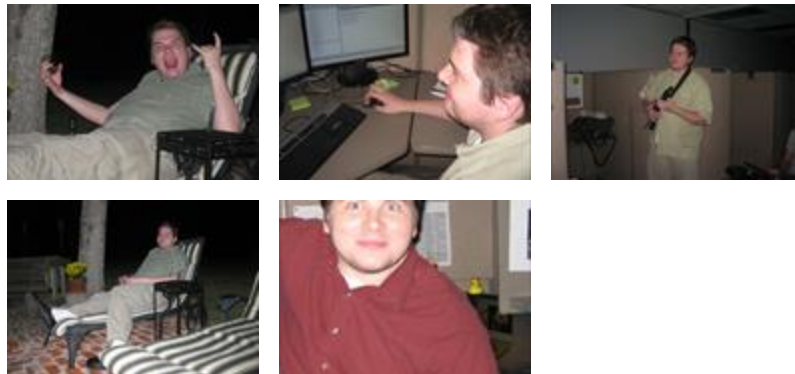
