SGT Shaun Paul Tousha, age 30, passed away on April 9, 2008, while serving in Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. SGT Tousha was born in Hull, Texas on February 11, 1978, to Tommy and Roberta Tousha. He graduated from Hull-Daisetta High School where he played football. In his spare time SGT Tousha loved bull riding. SGT Tousha joined the Army on February 25, 2000. He served his entire enlistment at Fort Hood, Texas assigned as a Generator Equipment Repairman for F Co, 1-66AR, 1BCT, 4ID. He was serving his third combat tour in Iraq. SGT Tousha is survived by his spouse of 3 years, Christy I. Tousha and two children, Colton and Maycee Burns. He is preceded in death by his parents. Services will be held at 10 AM Thursday April 17, 2008 at Sam Houston Memorial Funeral Home Chapel with interment to follow at Boswell Cemetery.
