



## Sharon Yvonne Bradley

March 25, 1950 - July 29, 2024

Sharon Yvonne Bradley passed away peacefully on Monday, July 29, 2024, as a result of complications from recent heart surgery. Sharon was “a fighter” as her doctor described her, but her body was too weak to overcome the infection. Sharon was born on March 25, 1950, to Hardy B. and Nell M. Carter Bradley in Houston, Texas. Later her two brothers, Ronnie and Michael, completed the family unit. She graduated from Smiley High School and then attended DeLynn Beauty School. In 1975 the Bradley family moved to Huntsville, Texas. Sadly, after a few short months, Sharon’s father, Hardy, suffered a massive heart-attack and died. Sharon quickly became responsible for caring for the needs of her family, and she faced the challenge with resiliency and determination. Sharon loved Huntsville, her church, Pine Prairie Free Will Baptist Church, and all of her friends, who opened their hearts to her sometimes-awkward social skills. Elvis Presley was also her favorite, and pictures and memorabilia of the recording artist adorned her house.
