Sherry L. (Krause) Murray died at her home in Huntsville, Texas on February 12, 2017 with her family by her side, following a courageous battle with cancer.

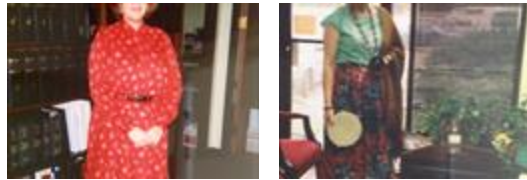
