



## Stanford Robert Wilson

Stanford Wilson, age 86, passed away early Saturday evening from natural causes. Stan was born and raised in Lenoir, North Carolina. Stan served in the Navy during WW II from 1942-1946. Stan then served in the Army during the Korean War from 1950-1966 at which time he retired as a Major with multiple service medals. Stan worked as the head of security for Texas Commerce Bank in Houston until he retired in 1993. Stan served as a Deacon for many years and also dedicated his time as a Gideon. At the time of his death he was serving as a Deacon at the First Baptist Church of Montgomery, Texas.
