Stanley C. Kelley, Jr. passed away on Saturday, October 17, 2020 in Heath, TX. He was born in Okmulgee, OK on October 9, 1939 to Mary Kathryn and Stanley Kelley. He grew up in Pasadena, TX where he met and married his high school sweetheart, Victori "Vicki" Segraves, in 1956.

Stanley worked as a letter carrier with the U.S. Postal Service in Pasadena for more than 30 years. Both he and Vicki were competitive runners and active in the running community in the greater Houston area. At age 52, Stanley retired and moved with Vicki to Alpine, TX where they had vacationed for several years and participated in fitness camps with friends from all over the state.
